HOLIDAYS IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

The school year in England usually finishes in the third week of July and starts in the first or second week of September. In Scotland, school breaks up at the end of June and starts again in the second week of August. So school children in the United Kingdom have about six weeks of summer holidays.

Many children go away with their families for one or two of those weeks. The traditional holiday is at the seaside. Families stay in hotels or caravans at holiday resorts on the coast. The children play on the beach and swim in the sea. Some families go touring in their cars and stay at bed and breakfast hotels in different places each night. Bed and breakfast means you sleep and have your breakfast at the hotel.

Some families like to go abroad for their holidays, especially if they want good weather. The weather in the United Kingdom can change very quickly. It can be warm and dry one day, but cold and wet the next day. So people like to go to the beaches of Italy or Spain where the sun always shines.

Not all families go away for their holidays. Some families stay at home and go on day trips. They visit a castle or perhaps go to a zoo during the day, and then come home in the evening. There are many theme parks in the United Kingdom where children and adults can go. Safari parks or wildlife parks are also very popular.

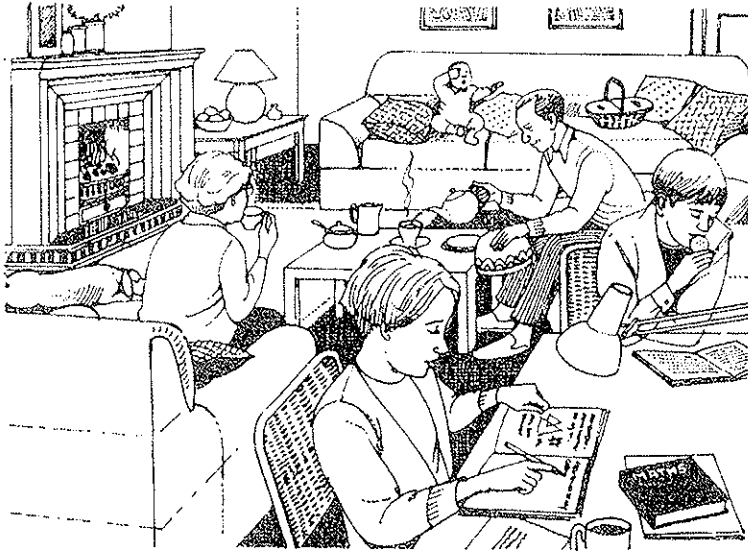
