SOCIAL MEDIA

I'm sure you have heard of Facebook and Twitter. In fact, you probably use them. These two websites are the most popular social media websites. But what exactly is “social media”? It can be defined as media that people use to interact, connect and communicate with each other. In this type of media people usually create and share pictures, writing or videos that they make themselves.

In general, there are six kinds of social media:

- * Some media involve working together with others. Wikipedia is an example of this.
- * Blogs and microblogs, such as Twitter are another category.
- * There are other websites where you can share videos or pictures. Youtube is the most well-known website of this type.
- * Another class of social media is social networking sites that allow people to stay in touch with friends or make new ones. Facebook is an example of this type of site.
- * Many people like to play games on the Internet and there are social media games.
- * The final type is websites like Second life, where people can create avatars.

Social media are very different from traditional media because they are produced very fast, it takes only a few minutes to write a Twitter post, for example.

Some people think social media are good and some think they are bad. But whatever you may think social media are here to stay.




